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Theraplay[®]

Theraplay is a type of therapeutic play that helps children and their carers to form positive, healthy and secure attachments. It is a structured form of play that is led and organised by the adult whilst being responsive to the child's specific needs.

The MIM (Marshak Interaction Method) is an assessment specific to the Theraplay model that can be used to examine the relationship between the child and his/her carers.

The training covers opportunities to:

- Observe the treatment of a family, including MIM assessment, feedback, Theraplay sessions
- Watch videos of Theraplay sessions covering a range of clients including family Theraplay, Group Theraplay in settings and schools, adolescents, infants, complex families and children with SEN
- Practise the use of Theraplay techniques
- Plan a Theraplay session
- Learn how to administer the MIM and analyse it at a beginner level

The training is designed to teach the basics for participants to begin to use Theraplay techniques in their work with existing and new clients.

Participants will need to purchase the 3rd Edition Theraplay Manual (Amazon or theraplay.uk/org) and read the first three chapters prior to the training
